Young Choreographer's Forum 2014 Guidelines for Application

Young Choreographer's Forum (YCF) is a mentorship program and is part of Mark Foehringer Dance Project|SF (MFDP|SF) educational programming. This is the sixth year of Young Choreographer's Forum. Each year we select up to 10 young dance makers to participate.

This program is intended to offer an opportunity to workshop choreography and get feedback from this expert panel of dance professionals.

Applicants must agree to attend all sessions and commit to the requirements set up by the curator, Mark Foehringer. Applicants must be between ages 16-24. Only new works will be accepted. No solos will be accepted.

There are three sessions with the panel of professionals. The first session is on October 27 from noon to 3 pm. During this session the choreographers share their concepts and ideas about their proposed project. The second session is optional and is on a sign up basis. This session is to work one on one with a panelist. The third session is on February 23 from noon to 3 pm. During this session the participants show the works in progress to the panel. All sessions will be held at Joe Goode Annex, 499 Alabama Street # 150, San Francisco, CA.

This year's panel is; Lizz Roman , director of Lizz Roman and Dancers; Susan Weber, associate director of Berkeley Ballet Theatre, formerly with Lar Lubovitch Dance Company; Brian Fisher, former dancer of ODC Dance SF and currently with MFDP|SF; Diane Frank, Lecturer in the Dance Division of the Dept. of Theater & Performance Studies at Stanford University.
